INTERDISCIPLINARY STUDIES WITH PRACTICE-ORIENTED INSIGHTS

The International Academy offers the opportunity to complete a one or two semester interdisciplinary study program in English at the high-ranking Ravensburg-Weingarten University of Applied Sciences (RWU), located in the South of Germany, Baden-Württemberg.

Since the International Academy was developed by the Faculty of Technology and Management of the RWU - more than 10 years ago - the program has been continuously refined and adapted to actual market challenges and strategic realignments of companies. As a result, the International Academy offers an interdisciplinary, forward-thinking study program covering both, theoretical frameworks as well as practical approaches.

Our program is directed to international exchange students from our partner universities all over the world as well as to students of the RWU, who want to improve their English skills and thus their career prospects. The main focus of the program lies on business and corporate management as well as on business development and innovation management.

Students can start the program either in winter or in summer semester.



OUR PROGRAM:ENTREPRENEURIAL THINKING, DECISION-MAKING AND ACTING

The International Academy has got its own study program focusing on current business developments with special emphasis on practical relevance, orientation to international business and interdisciplinary activities.

In the winter semester, lectures focus on International Business Management, whereas in summer, lectures deal with Innovation Management and New Technologies in the Business Environment.

All our students with divers cultural backgrounds gain practical experience in their courses by working in international teams. By means of case studies and various research projects, they get prepared for multilateral and interdisciplinary challenges international companies constantly have to face.

In only two semesters, our students take a great leap forward in direction of international entrepreneurial thinking and acting.

YOUR STUDIES

Semester 1

The first semester focuses on the major principles of international business management. Specially designed courses provide our students with international management tools. In addition, personal skills are strengthened in order to cope with intercultural demands. Entrepreneurship, leadership and intercultural expertise are the key topics of the first semester.

Semester 2

The second semester coaches the students for the interface between economics and technology in companies, being the key function of the Faculty of Technology and Management.

Optional courses

We highly recommend our international students to participate in a German language course (German as a foreign language) being offered by our Center for Languages and Intercultural Communication.

Elective courses

Elective courses are offered every semester, complementing the main fields of the International Academy program. Further information regarding the availability of elective courses can be found online before the beginning of the semester.

Note

Both semesters of the program are closely linked with each other. However, there is no relevant order. Therefore students can start the program with either of the two semesters.
