The awardees shall contribute to creating a culture of welcome at Hochschule Ravensburg-Weingarten. The award is not related to academic accomplishments.
Target group	Regularly enrolled international students, i.e. Bachelor students in an advanced semester (at least 2nd or 3rd year of studying) or rather Master students (at least 2nd Semester). Recent graduates (no more than three months should have passed since gaining the degree at the time of the award ceremony) and students seeking a doctor's degree are allowed to be nominated.	Regularly enrolled German and international students as well as recent graduates (no more than one year should have passed since removal from the register of students at the time of the award ceremony).
