German Language Courses/ Deutsch als Fremdsprache (DaF)	German is taught for beginners and advanced learners from level A1 – C1, courses are free of charge. Language courses from A1 – B2 start with an intensive course between the Welcome Days and the beginning of the lecture period and are continued throughout the lecture period on Wed. mornings (4hrs/ week). Dates for the intensive German language course: Winter semester: 2023/24: 18.09.23. – 29.09.24 Summer semester: 2024: 04.03.23 – 10.03.24 (tbc)

Cost of living	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 98,50 € semester admin fee (2nd sem. 90€), - 260/335 €/month for housing in Briach dorms + private liability insurance (sum insured: min 10 Mio €) – family insurance valid if sum insured is at least 10 Mio €, otherwise an insurance for 5€/ month or 65€ for a full year can be taken out in Germany - approx. 250-300 €/ month for food, - approx. 120 €/ month for German public health insurance (for non-EU students) <p>Public transport: local bus ride: 2.50 € (free on Sun., Sat. after 4pm). With a semester ticket (“Studiticket”), avail. for approx. 127 €/ semester, public transport is free at all times in the whole BODO region (optional).</p>
